**BACKGROUND:** During the Kiwanis International training session for Service Leadership administrators in January 2007 at the American Airlines training facility in Dallas, Texas, the PNW District administrators collectively rated our district programs at that time as mediocre to good. It was decided then and there by all of us in attendance that we must raise the status of our programs from good to GREAT and do it fast.

## **GOVERNOR'S PROJECT GOAL:**

- Increase the number of Service Leadership Programs in the District.
- Increase the number of members in our Service Leadership Programs.
- Increase the Service hours and Projects accomplished by our Service Leadership Programs.
- Increase the Kiwanis Club support to these programs both financially and physically.

## **CRITERIA FOR GOVERNOR'S AWARD:**

To qualify for the SLP builder's award a Kiwanis club must:

- a. Establish a Terrific Kids Program or the BUG Program in two or more Elementary Schools or,
- b. Establish a new K-Kids Program in an Elementary School, or
- c. Establish a new Builders program in a Middle school, or
- d. Establish a new KEY Club in a High School, or
- e. Establish a new CKI Club in a University or Jr. College. Or
- f. Establish or assist in establishing a new AKTION club.

To qualify for the SLP participation award a Kiwanis club must:

- a. Sponsor 2 or more students to any one KEY LEADER Session.
- b. Donate \$200.00 or more to the PNW Out reach program

To qualify for the Governor's SLP award for OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT, a Kiwanis club must accomplish an item in each of the above 2 categories.
